Daily Illini Newspaper (41/8/801)

These newspapers are fully digitized through 1975 and are a wealth of information about local and campus goings-on. Fully text searchable, and the database allows you to search through all scanned volumes at once, making this a great starting point for any research topic.

Board of Trustees Reports (1/1/802)

These reports are the key to jumping into almost any University-related topic in the Archives. The BOT votes and reports on just about everything that goes on at the University. We have print volumes of these in the reading room which are all indexed. There are several digital access points for these.

Search all digitized BOT reports at once. The caveat is that sometimes the AI doesn't properly recognize the text, so if you're not getting results in a spot you think you should be, try checking one of these other access points for a range of relevant years.
